MTSS Teaming Structures

A Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) is a standards-aligned, comprehensive school improvement framework for enhancing academic, behavioral, and social-emotional outcomes for ALL students. To best serve the students within an MTSS framework, cross-disciplinary teams are established at the various tiers of instruction. The roles and responsibilities of these teams are determined by the need of support at each tier.

MTSS Teaming Structures

<p>How Often? Monthly</p> <p>Who? MTSS coach, administrator, reading/math specialist, teacher representatives across all grade levels.</p> <p>Purpose? Analyze school-wide data to ensure that 80 percent of students are meeting success criteria. Problem-solve Tier 1 strategies to ensure core instruction is research-based, standards-aligned, and effective.</p>	<p>How Often? Weekly – Every other week</p> <p>Who? Reading/Math specialist, MTSS coach, behavioral specialist, counselor, school psychologist, teacher representative.</p> <p>Purpose? Assign evidence-based academic/behavioral interventions for students who are at-risk based on screening data. Monitor students' progress monitoring data to determine whether the interventions are effective.</p>	<p>How Often? Weekly – Every other week</p> <p>Who? Reading/Math specialist, MTSS coach, behavioral specialist, counselor, school psychologist, teacher representative.</p> <p>Purpose? Intensify/individualize interventions for students who are not responding to Tier 2 interventions. Monitor students' progress monitoring data to determine whether the interventions are effective.</p>
