Teacher's job:		Student's job:	
1. Uses <b>attention getter</b>		1. <b>Responds</b> to attention getter	
2. Asks student to <b>predict</b> what story is about		2. Student makes a <b>prediction</b> (does not have to be accurate)	
3. Asks student to point to the <b>title</b>		3. Points to <b>title</b>	
4. Asks student to point to <b>author</b>		4. Points to <b>author</b>	
5. Gives student opportunity to <b>open the book</b>		5. <b>Opens</b> the book	
6. Reads story/ gives student opportunity to anticipate <b>repeated story line</b>		6. <b>Anticipates</b> repeated story line using their voice or assistive technology to read it	
7. Gives student opportunity to <b>point to each word</b> as read		7. <b>Points</b> to words as teacher points	
8. Gives student opportunity to identify <b>key vocabulary word</b> or picture in text		8. Correctly " <b>reads</b> "/ finds the <b>key vocabulary</b> word or picture in text	
9. Gives student opportunity to <b>turn pages</b> as read story		9. <b>Turns</b> one or more pages	
10. Asks one or more <b>comprehension questions</b>		10. Answers <b>comprehension questions</b> correctly
