Pennsylvania public LEAs, Approved Private schools, Intermediate Units, and Career Tech Ed Centers will be considered

LEAs who previously received TD funding Licensed Private schools



#### The Transition Discoveries Model

#### Action plan implementation is supported by:

- Curriculum for Stakeholders to learn about Evidencebased transition practices.
- Transition Curriculum for Students
- Online TD Community of Practice

Addressing areas for growth



Supporting high-quality transition planning (indicator 13/14) at a systems-level.

#### STAGE FOUR

The T-CAT, LEA and community members create and implement a systems-level action plan for the priority area. Together, they use TD's action planning process.

Stage 4 Training

#### STAGE THREE

Your team will establish the Transition Change Agent Team (T-CAT) of young people, families and additional stakeholders

Stage 3 Training

#### **STAGE TWO**

Your team will identify priorities for community action planning from the TDQI data

Stage 2 Training

#### STAGE ONE

Your team will use the TDQI to collect data from youth, families and stakeholders across schools, agencies and community partners about effective transition and what can be improved.

# A Few Examples of Outcomes!


#### LEAs who have implemented TD have...

  - Linking Middle school + High School
- Transition Coordinating Council policies, committees designed for youth with disabilities to become active members


## Year 1 Deliverables
