

2020-2021 Competitive Integrated Employment (CIE) Grants

The Pennsylvania Department of Education, Bureau of Special Education annually awards Competitive Integrated Employment (CIE) grants to local education agencies interested in establishing or expanding effective competitive integrated employment programming for youth with disabilities.

For the 2020-2021 school year, 13 establishment grants were awarded, and 8 expansion grants were awarded.
