The Supplementary Aids and Services (SaS) Consideration Toolkit provides IEP teams a process to determine the supports and services a student needs in order to be successful. Using the SaS Toolkit, teams analyze the instructional, physical, and social environment of a general education classroom from the perspective of an individual student. The intended outcome of using the SaS Toolkit is to identify a list of environmentallyreferenced supplementary aids and services to enhance participation and learning for a student with a disability in the general education classroom.
