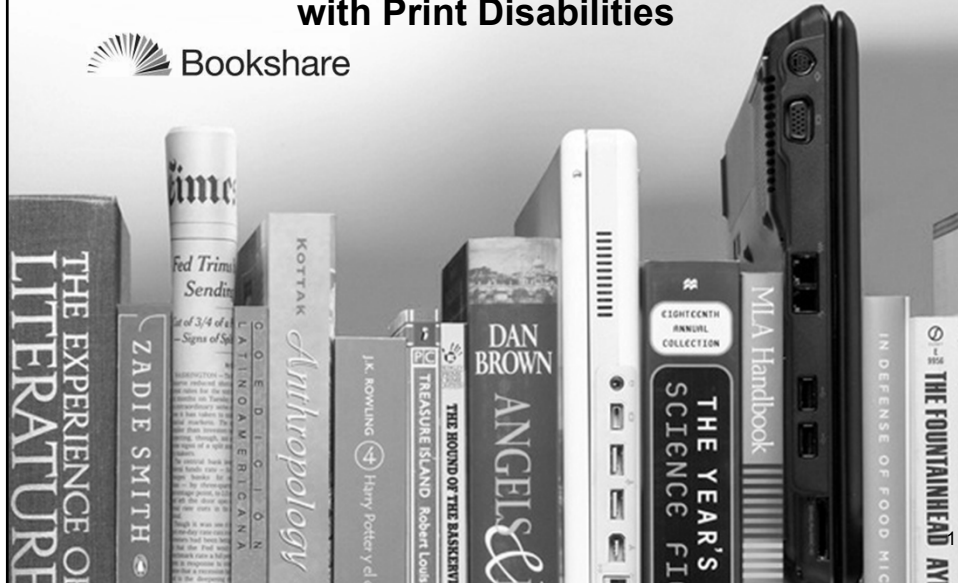

Legal Provisions



Provisions within IDEA 2004

- Require state and local education agencies to ensure that textbooks and related core instructional materials are provided to students with print disabilities in specialized formats in a timely manner.
- Establish NIMAS and NIMAC

Section 300. 172, Final Regulations of IDEA 2004



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Timely Manner

At the same time as other students receive their core instructional materials in print format.





Section 300.172, Final Regulations of IDEA 2004



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Legal Provisions

 Some students served under Chapter 15 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 may also qualify as persons with print disabilities and need AEM.



 If the team develops a 504 Plan for a student, it should consider the student's needs for AEM.

Who Needs AEM?

-  If any student is unable to read traditional grade level print instructional materials
- ☐ at a sufficient rate and with adequate comprehension to complete academic tasks with success, relative to same-age peers,
 - ☐ or cannot do this independently,
 - ☐ or cannot do this across environments and tasks,
-  then the student *may* need AEM.

NIMAS

- 📖 National Instructional Materials Accessibility Standard specified in IDEA
- 📖 A standard used by publishers to produce source files that may be used to develop specialized formats for K-12 students with print disabilities.
- 📖 NIMAS files are not student-ready files.

- 📖 Established under IDEA 2004
- 📖 Repository for publisher textbook files (NIMAS files)
- 📖 Bookshare converts NIMAS files into specialized formats
- 📖 Only students who qualify under the Chafee Amendment AND have IEPs are eligible for NIMAC-sourced files

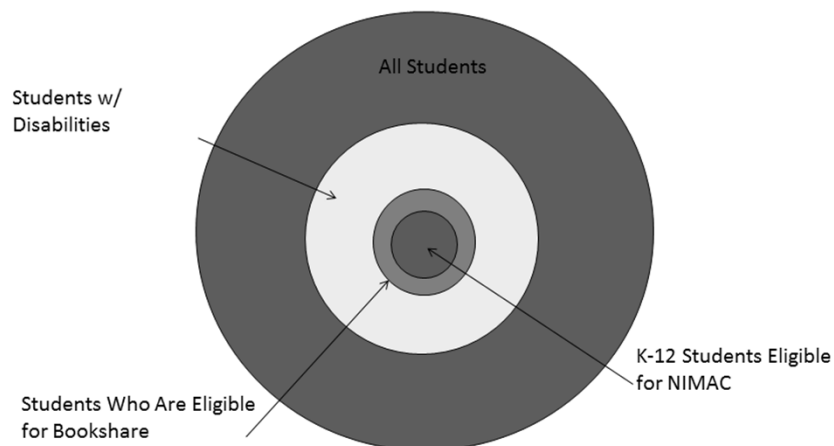
Bookshare is authorized to produce digital books in accessible formats through an exemption in the U.S. copyright law called the Chafee Amendment.

Students' Eligibility for Bookshare and NIMAC



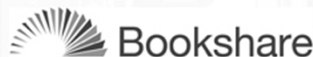

Purchase Order Language for NIMAS files

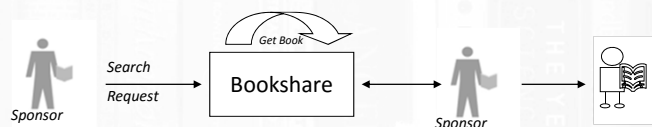
By agreeing to deliver the materials marked with "NIMAS" on this contract or purchase order, the publisher agrees to prepare and submit, on or before _____ a NIMAS file set to the NIMAC that complies with the terms and procedures set forth by the National Instructional Materials Access Center (NIMAC), (IDEA Title I, Part D, sec. 674(e)). The publisher also agrees to mark up materials eligible for NIMAS submission that contain mathematical and scientific instructional content by using the MathML3 (refer to latest applicable version) module of the DAISY/NIMAS Structure Guidelines as posted and maintained at the DAISY Consortium web site (<http://www.daisy.org/z3986/structure/SG-DAISY3/index.html>). Should the vendor be a distributor of the materials and not the publisher, the distributor agrees to immediately notify the publisher of its obligation to submit NIMAS file sets of the purchased products to the NIMAC. The files will be used for the production of alternate formats as permitted under the law for students with print disabilities (IDEA Title I, Part B, sec. 612(a)).

Bookshare as a State Authorized User

- Search Bookshare's Web site for textbook
- If book is not found in Bookshare, search the NIMAC (<http://nimac.us>)
- If book is in the NIMAC, use **Contact Us** to request the book <https://www.bookshare.org/contactUs>. Provide ISBN, title and author.
- Also, you can request the book through the Book Request form: <https://www.bookshare.org/bookRequest>
- Bookshare gets book ready for student and sends email
- Sponsor downloads book for qualified student
- Average turn-around: 7-10 business days

Reading Lists


- 📖 Similar to physical bookshelves
- 📖 Sponsors and Individual Members can compile book titles in one location
- 📖 Primarily used to organize and classify the titles that you have already downloaded and/or the ones that you want to download in the future
- 📖 Sponsors can create Reading Lists and easily share with students so they can download books on their own – including NIMAC books
- 📖 A Sponsor can create a "syllabus" to assign to one or more members, allowing students with individual accounts to access from home



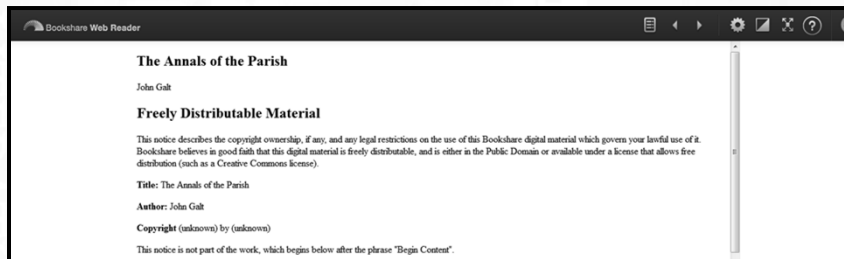
