

Indicator 13: Effective and Compliant Transition Practices

Indicator 13 is a federal reporting requirement of the percentage of youth aged 16 and above who have an IEP that includes coordinated, measurable annual IEP goals and transition services that will reasonably enable the students to meet their post-secondary goals. However, Pennsylvania begins the process of transition planning at age 14.

During this webinar, LEA representatives will be provided with information regarding the training requirements, compliance requirements, and resources to enhance the development of effective transition practices. Participants will be given tools which will allow them to critically review IEPs to ensure effective secondary transition practices are established and implemented. The tools will also assist teachers in enhancing the development of IEPs.
