# Purposeful Transition: Map It-What Comes Next

## **Course Description:**

Map It-What Comes Next is an interactive, accessible online transition training developed for youth who are deaf or hard of hearing. This two day training will walk professionals through Map It and demonstrate how to use it in the classroom with students. The core topics will include compliance with Indicator 13, preparing students for transition after high school, supporting student development of self-advocacy and self-determination, helping students develop realistic future goals, and supporting student-led IEP meetings.

#### Presenter:

Heather Holmes currently works with Pepnet 2 which is funded by the U.S Department of Education to increase education, career, and lifetime choices available to individuals who are deaf or hard of hearing. Her office is housed at the Western Oregon University. Her responsibilities include developing online trainings, providing personnel development and technical assistance to teachers, and vocational rehabilitation. Her areas of interest include youth transition, accessibility, and online learning. Heather has a Master's degree in Education in Information Technology from Western Oregon University, and a B.A. from Arizona State University.

For the 2016-2017 school year, participants will be asked to participate in ongoing data collection and will receive technical assistance to support implementation.

This training is for teachers of the deaf, transition specialists, vocational rehabilitation counselors, parents and administrators.
