CALI – Categories and Attributes of Language Inventory

The Categories and Attributes of Language Inventory (CALI) examines the ability to form word relationships through the use of categorization, association, and attributes. It identifies areas of strength and need for word recall and knowledge.

The examiner states, 'Tell me all you know about (name the word)' and then records what is said according to type of response and ranks with #1 being the first word or phrase said and continuing in order of expression.

Use the Practice activity to prompt for all word relationship areas. If no initial response is given, ask one of the question to elicit a response. No prompt is given for test items.
